

<p>Double white line query on the brow of the hill, left of Cholderton Road, exiting the A338 – confirmation from Cllr Smale that he has been further researching the possibility of placing the lining, with the relevant authority – further updates confirmed as being expected in the future.</p> <p>Clarification of VAT claims regarding NTPC and NT Management Hall Committee – the Clerk confirmed that following liaison checks with the relevant organisation that the Parish Council is not allowed to claim refunds for VAT on e.g. purchases/works incurred on behalf of the NTMHC.</p> <p>Following note made of the need to have remedial works undertaken on the “Cholderton Road” sign post, located on entry to the Cholderton Road proper and before the cemetery – Clerk confirmed this had been duly reported to the relevant department at WC and for the necessary repairs to be undertaken. In addition the signage “Beechfield” at the junction of the Cholderton Road and Beechfield identified as in need of repainting – Clerk to notify relevant department at WC.</p>	Clerk

Highways</p> <p>20mph speed limit consideration – following receipt from WC of information regarding this item and consideration by the Parish Council, it was noted that the Parish Council were in favour of an overall 20mph speed limit being introduced in the Parish.</p> <p>Street naming and numbering consultation - relevant documents perused with agreement by the Council on preference option B and available to view at www.wiltshire.gov.uk/streetnaming.</p>

Finance</p> <p>Clerk distributed the Parish Council’s spreadsheet to the Council members with details of the Council’s financial accounts and transactions for October which were then approved.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The following invoices were approved: Shaw Trust (September maintenance) £220.02. <p>Concern raised and noted at the cost of the tarmacing of the basketball area.</p> <p>Clerk distributed a spreadsheet detailing the income and expenditure for 2010 and budgetary information for consideration of the precept at the November meeting where a decision is envisaged to be made for the precept request 2011/12 – all Councillors asked to peruse in time for the November meeting.</p>	All Cllr’s
<p>9. Planning</p> <p>S/2010/1385/ A338 & A303, Cholderton, Salisbury, SP4 0EW - 4 no. free standing signs (retrospective) – Parish Council discussed and refused the application.</p>	
<p>10. Community Asset Transfer – Allotments</p> <p>Following prior research it was stated that the site in question considered for this matter was too small to be considered for an allotment site and that the land was in fact under the jurisdiction of WC with the resident tenants.</p>

<p>Confirmation that the web master had been asked to update the site with regards to notices and their respective dates. It was identified that there is a need for more input/information to the site and Cllr Eley agreed to liaise with the web master to further discuss this matter.</p>	Cllr Eley

Neighbourhood Watch</p> <p>Following information from the Neighbourhood Watch team regarding Smart Water Technology Ltd and decision to purchase ten of the kits the Clerk confirmed that this had been done with the receipt of the kits awaited.</p> <p>An update was given by the two Parish Council representatives with regard to recent incidences in the Parish and with reference to a report recently produced by the local police. One particular item of note was the apparent incidence of dogs attacking farm animals – it was agreed that an article would be placed on the web page and parish magazine to highlight this matter.</p>	Cllr Eley
<p>13. Report from MHMC representative</p> <p>As the representative for the MHMC was not present a report had not been submitted and was unable to be given.</p>	
<p>14. Parish Steward</p> <p>Note made that the Parish Steward had visited on the 6th October 2010 with the next visit planned for 3rd November 2010. Reference was made to document from WC regarding an overview of the scheme and that the PS is now carrying out a “find and fix” scheme which has apparently resulted in a far higher number of defects being repaired each month. Councillors were encouraged to liaise with the Parish Council representative for the scheme in order to report any necessary works and that the representative intended to personally meet with the Steward each month in order to confirm the reports in person.</p>	All Cllr's
<p>15. Correspondence</p> <p>Environment Agency – notification of a Wiltshire Flood Seminar on 19th October 2010.</p> <p>Request from Cllr Miles for a donation to be made to the Wiltshire Archaeology and Natural History Society – discussed and declined.</p>

Any other business</p> <p>Note made by Cllr Smale of a planned meeting to discuss the A338 Working Group on 1st November 2010.</p> <p>Confirmation given and reminder of the arranged compactor vehicle to the Parish on 30th October 2010.</p> <p>Thanks given to the Clerk on the recent preparation and despatch to the Council members of the 2011 meeting dates.</p> <p>Confirmation received by Cllr Stubbs that he intended to resign from his position of Chairman of the Parish Council but remain as a Councillor with effect from the November meeting – Councillors were asked to consider the position and to express an interest should they be interested with an election to be held at the November meeting where a decision would be made.</p>
